A. You will fill out your application online. It should take about 45 minutes to complete the application.

We suggest that you draft your answers on a separate text editor first (e.g. MS Word) before copy and paste into the application form. Once you have submitted, you will be unable to revise your application. B. Completed Application list will be updated every Monday at 5:00 PM in the Online Application tab. Please check and let us know if your information is not listed as it supposes to be.

C. Application deadline: 11:00 PM, Oct 10, 2025.

D. The ONLY required document you need before starting the application is your official GPA transcript signed and stamped by your university. This should be the complete GPA with all grades starting from the first year till now (preferably in 10.0 scale). Note that we only accept the GPA transcript with issue date from July, 2025 up till now. Please scan this file in PDF format.

If you fill out the Social Activity & Project section and/or the Achievement section, please also submit your Certificates (in PDF format) related to your Social Activity & Project and/or Achievement.

IMPORTANT:

We appreciate your integrity. If any information in your application is proved to be incorrect during the program, we have the right to disqualify your application and withdraw your award scholarship.

You can apply for AmCham Scholarship only ONCE. Please make sure that you have prepared to apply.

English is the ONLY language used throughout the Scholarship Program.

The final round (Interview Day) is held physically in Ho Chi Minh City. Eligible candidates MUST be physically present to attend.
